Come out for the fourth annual running of the only trail race with an age graded start (that we know of) on the east coast. Top age group performers have a legitimate shot at the overall title. Even if you aren't out to win, the race is run on challenging yet very runnable trails in beautiful Nolde Forest, has great schwag and virtually no bottle necks. Challenge your families and coworkers to come out and compete on a "level" playing field... Hey ringers: Here's a chance to show off a little by passing the whole pack! The top 10 in 2012 had 5 men and 5 women spread over 10 different age groups.

What's an age graded start. Those who have more than a few of grey hairs or have yet to hit puberty will get a head start based on age and gender. Typically the oldest female wave starts first. Then the next wave will start, based on 5 year age groups, working back toward the younger (faster?) folks. Wave starts will bounce back and forth between sexes, as the handicap derived from the World Masters Association dictates. The actual handicap for each division is posted at **www.PagodaPacers.com** and will be declared final for 2013 a month prior to start. That means you start with your age group (call them your competition if you like). Your handicap division may or may not start with another handicap division. For example, it's possible that 60-64 year old men might start at the same time as 50-54 year old women. Or maybe not...

We race in rain or other inclement weather. Race director reserves the right to delay the start of the race due to mega foul weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Check www.pagodapacers.com scroll bar for postponement info if weather is hurricane-like race day. No refunds, no mailed hats, bags or awards; no whiners, no alcohol (Nolde Forest Rule). Bring Cash/Check; no ATM.

YOU GET: Great Schwag! Last 3 years had unique tote bag and tech runner's hats! Expect something similar this year. Indoor registration & toilets, food at the finish, HUGE post race raffle (Did we mention a pair of Southwest Airline Tickets!?!), two water stops, finish place posted immediately & results on www.pretzelcitysports.com then www.pagodapacers.com in 1-2 days. Other surprises not yet finalized.

COURSE: A wheel measured, well marked 10K course over the beautiful trails in Nolde forest. VERY pretty and scenic with less ankle busting rocks than most other Berk's parks. You'll scramble over some rocks and go off trail to get dirty too. The race will start in front of the Environmental Education Building and head directly in the forest after minimal time on pavement. **Most trails are wide enough for easy passing.** The finish will be right near the start in front of the Nolde Mansion. A map of the course is on the Pagoda Pacer website and will be available before the race.

LOCATION: Race held in Nolde Forest, Cumru Township, Berks County, PA, just south of Reading PA. The race will start and end near the Nolde Mansion. **Note: Enter via Main Entrance, <u>NOT</u> the SawMill Parking Lot**!!

DIRECTIONS: 6 miles south of Reading, on PA Rt. 625 (New Holland Rd). 2 miles south of PA 724 and 3 miles North of PA 568. Address: Nolde Forest Environmental Education Center 2910 New Holland Rd Reading, PA 19607

PARKING: Parking near the mansion is <u>extremely</u> limited. **Please, please, please carpool and get there early!** We will have volunteers directing you where to park to use every available space. Please follow their directions.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARENTS: If your child is 17 yrs old or less, and wishes to run, you MUST be present for the duration of the race. You may also run (we encourage it!). It is highly doubtful that your child may get hurt, but if he/she does, medical personnel can ONLY treat him/her with your permission.
