- Grades 3-6: 1.5 miles
- Grades 7-8: 2.35 miles
- Grades 9-12: 3.1 miles (5K)

While the race is transpiring, we will have an inflatable obstacle course as well as Leading Edge Martial Arts for our younger aspiring biathletes to play until their siblings/cousins/friends experience their spectacular finish at the Southern Lehigh Football Stadium. Timing is done by the GREAT Pretzel City Sports...of course the timing will be correct. Awards will be given for all categories for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} , for male and female.
