WHO: Runners of all ages. Gather your family, friends and coworkers. Superhero Costumes optional for Kids and the young at heart. Walkers are also invited to participate using the same course. The course is stroller and wheelchair accessible. This is to raise money for children's nutritional programs in developing regions.

WHERE: Hugh Moore Park and Canal Museum - 2750 Hugh Moore Park Rd, Easton PA *18042*; Registration/number pickup at the Canal Museum entrance, starting at 9:00. This is a Beautiful, FAST, FLAT, TRAFFIC-FREE route.

WHEN: Saturday, May 25, 2019
8:30 a.m. – Registration begins
10:00 a.m.– 5K Run begins
10:30 a.m. – 1/2 Mile Fun Run for Ages 12 & Under
11:15 a.m. – Award presentation at finish line for the 5K

DIRECTIONS: FROM U.S. ROUTE 22: Take the 25th Street exit and turn south at the end of the ramp. Follow 25th Street south approximately 1.5 miles, then turn right onto Lehigh Drive. At the stop sign, turn right onto the green metal bridge. Turn right at the end of the bridge to go into the park.

FROM I-78: Take Route 33 north to Freemansburg Avenue. At the end of the ramp, turn right (east). Stay on Freemansburg to 25th Street (look for the Aldi store on your right). Turn right on 25th Street and go south approximately .5 miles, then turn right onto Lehigh Drive. At the stop sign, turn right onto the green metal bridge. Turn right at the end of the bridge to go into the park. Follow the road for parking, picnic facilities and the canal boat.

ALL parking is in the large lot before the gate Registration will be located near the Canal Museum Entrance
