Lebanon City is identified as a 'Medically Underserved Area/ Population' and is the residence of 83 percent of the clinic's patients. Among this population, 29 percent live below the poverty level and approximately 63 percent are of low to moderate income. In 2018, approximately 12,000 working Lebanon County residents did not have health insurance and thus lacked access to primary care services. By offering free, preventative medical care to these hard-working, yet underserved members of our community, the patients miss less time from work, have fewer visits to the emergency room, and by staying healthy, workers can stay working to not only continue supporting their families, but still support the local economy.

Over the past 12 months, LVVIM has provided 7,500 treatments to 3,318 patients. Since the opening of the clinic, LVVIM serves on average 335 patients per month. In addition to the regular clinic, the walk-in part of the clinic serves on average 118 patients each month. Over the past 10 years, LVVIM has had over 500,000 volunteer hours donated and provided over 75,000 patient treatments.
