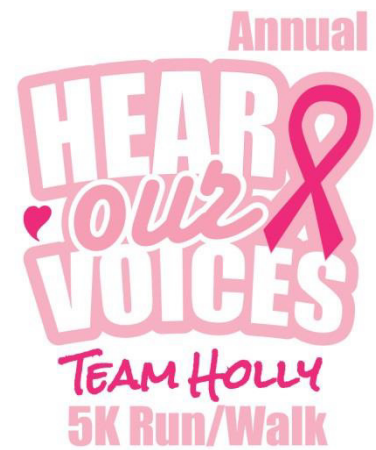


7th Annual Hear Our Voices:

LOCATION/REGISTRATION: Gring's Mill Recreation Center, 2083 Tulpehocken Road, Reading, PA 19610; Registration/number pickup at Gring's Mill Recreation Center starting at 8:30 a.m. Runners will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. Walkers will begin at 10:05 a.m. Course is out and back along the Union Canal Towpath Trail.

Awards ceremony to follow.

Even if we were tearing our hair out from being too busy while we were trapped in our homes, the bizarreness of our new daily lives had us reassessing & re-examining.

As for me, not being among friends, family or just strangers for extended periods of time drove home the fact of how we're primarily social creatures. Even if we were connected by phone, text, email or video, sometimes nothing can take the place of having someone actually THERE for you. We all learned how much we maybe took the daily face-to-face with others for granted.
