DIRECTIONS

From Pennsylvania Turnpike take Exit 286 (Reading), continue straight to the traffic light at Route 272

From Lancaster head north on Route 222 to the Denver/PA Tpk. Exit. Turn Left on to access road and continue to the traffic light at Route 272.

From Reading head south on Route 222 to the Denver/PA Tpk. Exit. Turn Right on to access road and continue to the traffic light at Route 272

At Route 272 Traffic Light turn LEFT on Route 272 (South). Continue on Route 272 for approximately 1.5 miles to the SECOND traffic light after the turn (Sunoco station on the right), turn RIGHT at the traffic light.

Continue on West Church St. for approximately 2 miles until you come to a traffic light. At the traffic light turn LEFT on South Fourth St.

Continue on South Fourth Street until you approach a split in the road (a church sits in the middle of the split).

At the split, bear RIGHT. Just past the school zone speed limit sign, turn RIGHT. The High School is located just past the elementary school and stadium.
