**Point-scoring race in the 2024 Mid-Atlantic USA T & F off-road series**

Michael Chobot (sounds like "Robot"), in his too-short 26 years, was AWESOME; yet somewhat of a "weird duck". A 2013 Emmy nominee in sound for a wildlife documentary entitled "Duckumentary", Michael marched to the beat of a different "drum, harmonica & kazoo". He developed a taste for Baked Beans over Egg Noodles when, while a struggling sound tech in NYC, he found both on sale at the same time. He refused to drink anything but chocolate milk on his 21<sup>st</sup> Birthday, maybe the ONLY day at Penn State that he DIDN'T have a beer in his hand. He totes a backpack with him everywhere containing oddities like a compass, astronaut food, a 1 lb bag of rice, a space blanket, twine, waterproof matches, a Swiss army knife and other things that only Michael could see the need to have with him at all times. He once carried a queen sized mattress overland for 2 miles on his back instead of using a truck available to him just to see if he could do it. Even till his passing in 2013, Michael wasn't just a "brother" or "son" or "sound engineer" or "trail runner" or "Penn Stater", he was a little bit of "everything". And the Chobot Challenge, on some of the same Berks Co's trails where Michael learned to run, is a little bit of "everything" too! It has long, gradual climbs that will tax you and long, gradual downhills where you'll run so fast that it will at least LOOK like you actually trained for this. It passes one of the prettiest sites in Eastern PA; a spot known to very few; even those living in this area. It has 4 narrow & ankle-deep creek crossings (one of the few races still with creek crossings) but no longer has any knee-deep crossing in it. You'll run everything from smooth single track to abandoned roads, with a pretty creekside start/finish, a covered pavilion, playground, some modern bathrooms, etc. on hand too. And naturally, it has all the other race aspects that make Pretzel City the top trail race organizer around. Come out & run the type of trails that gave Michael so much joy & happiness, cause they're sure to bring YOU joy & happiness as well! **NOTE: YOU RACE AT YOUR OWN RISK & ARE SOLEY RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR WELFARE WHILE RACING!** These trails are cleaner than a comic's monologue at a Southern Baptist Conference. But if you tweak something, drag your butt to the next aide station so we can get you out via fossil fuel. Get lost? Stevie Wonder could follow this course with no help. Since longer trail races are a little "tuff", entry is discouraged for 1) 13.25K runners that are 14 & under and plan to run alone (contact director for exceptions-often allowed) 2) anyone who finds Saturday Night Live hilarious (painful, is more like it) and anyone who grew up near Philly and inexplicitly is a Dallas Cowboy Fan, or, for that matter, ANY Cowboy fan!

**Do not fill out while drinking heavily, if possible -- Sign back of entry – Chobot app may be copied**

**Entry Fee/Registration for Both Races:** Races start at 9 AM, registration/packet pickup begins at 8 AM. **Fees:** **With short sleeve cotton shirt:** \$40 if entered by Mon, July 29, 2024. Afterwards, including raceday, \$45 while shirts last; \$40 when gone. **Without shirt:** \$35 if entered by Mon, July 29, 2024. Afterwards, including raceday, \$40. **WITH THE COST OF SHIRTS SKYROCKETING, WE WILL BE ORDERING EVEN FEWER EXTRA SHIRTS THAN IN THE PAST SO WE DON'T GET STUCK WITH HUNDREDS OF DOLLARS OF EXTRA SHIRTS WHICH IMPACTS WHAT WE CAN DONATE IN MICHAEL'S NAME!** Entering early is the ONLY way to be sure you get one. PRE-ENTER even if the price break has passed since entries entering after the price break date but before raceday get first dibs at the remaining shirts, based on their date of entry. Rain or shine, no refunds or mailed shirts/awards. No awards for Hike for Mike Fun Run/Walk. Due to the courses crossing each other which complicates our course markings, Fun Runners may be given maps of their course. **HIKERS ALLOWED ONLY IN THE 5K! IF DOING THE 13.25K (8.22 MILES), PLEASE DO NOT WALK MORE THAN 25% OF THE RUN SO WE CAN VACATE THE PARK FAIRLY EARLY SO IT CAN BE USED BY OTHERS.** Raceday entry permitted; only cash or check accepted for payment that day.

**Extras:** Lots of awards, covered registration area, good post race grub, instant results, results posted the next day on pretzelcitysports.com, WELL marked course if no one screws with it, 2 water stops for Trail run-1 for 5k, EMS on site, nice creekside start/finish area with picnic areas/playground, nice shirts with no ads on the back, so-so parking-carpool whenever possible, etc. NOTE: course not accessible by car. Also, shallow creek crossings on courses; 4 in the 13.25k, 2 in the 5k.

**Awards:** M & F 1st & 2nd overall plus: 0-29: 4M, 4F \* 30-39: 5M, 5F \* 40-49: 5M, 5F  
50-59:5M, 5F \* 60-67: 4M, 4F 68-74: 3, 2F 75+ : 2M, 1F Clydesdale: 3M, 3F

**Clydesdale Qualification:** Men: minimum of 210 lbs. or 185 if 5 ft., 9 inches tall or less. Women: minimum of 160 lbs., 140 if 5 ft., 4 inches tall or less. Honor system, no scale on site. MUST select the Clydesdale designation BEFORE the race begins.

**Directions from downtown Birdsboro (intersection of Rt 724 and Rt 345-next to Rita's Italian Ice and Sunoco MiniMart) to Rustic Park:** Go south on Furnace St (with the factories to your right) which will then turn into Haycreek Rd. The road will dead-end about 1 mile later. The parking lot to your right is for Rustic Park. There is also parking on Haycreek Road just before you enter the park; when selecting a spot, please be mindful of those living in the area.

**Address for GPS'ers:** Nearest home is 1230 Haycreek Rd, Birdsboro, PA. Park itself has no address.
