I met Holly for the first time shortly after I started my job as an oncology social worker at the Reading Hospital in early 2014 (10 years ago!!!). Holly was a young mom of two beautiful children who knew that one day, despite our best treatments, there would be a time when she wouldn't be with us any longer. How do you begin to think about doing such an impossible thing? So, I started meeting with Holly almost weekly when she came in for treatment and we decided that she wanted to do "something". She didn't know what, but I felt like she wanted to leave a legacy; do something that people would remember her for, something that would create community, hope, and joy in her name. Enter Breast Cancer Support Services of Berks County and the idea of doing a local 5K in the fall of that year to earn money for all of the incredible programs that are offered and had helped Holly so much along the way. Our first year we had 165 participants and raised \$3,032. When Holly passed just a couple of months



after that first race, there was so much momentum, love, and excitement that we decided to keep it going. We continued to run the race every year and last year we had 400 participants and raised \$28,000. Every year I get the chance to remember Holly and see how her family has grown, changed, and shows love for each other. When I stand at the start line, I always look around and hope that Holly can see how far her idea has stretched, how loved she is, and how her "something" helps keep her with us 10 years later. With the help of the proceeds of this race BCSS has been able to grow their programs incredibly. They are now offering 19 programs from Newly Diagnosed, to Young Survivors, to Lunch and Learns, and Creative Arts, etc. I'm honored to be asked to write the introduction this year. BCSS was a place Holly went to when she was lost and needed to find her footing. Because of Holly BCSS can continue to help hundreds of women, men, and families every year walk a similar path as Holly did through their breast cancer diagnosis and treatment. Without BCSS some of our patients would choose not to reach out at all so we are so very lucky to have BCSS in our own backyard! Please consider joining us and supporting BCSS.
