The trail follows the scenic Wissahickon Creek over the old Reading Railroad bridge (now a walking bridge – part of trail) to historic Militia Hill and back. The course consists of well-marked dirt and asphalt trails in shaded, wooded areas of the State Park. A great time of year for this run - the leaves turning and a chill in the air!
- Race Purpose:** To raise money for Scouting America Troops 541 and 542 and provide awareness of the values of Scouting.
